### **Profile**

Was born in Germany in 1983.

He started fish farming business with family, when his father started imported first recalcitrated system from Australia, for barramundi fish growing. In 2003 in Australia graduated bachelor degree in banking and finance at Curtin University of Technology and also attended Aquinas College in Perth WA, he continued the thought of expanding the small operation with the use of European Union funds that become available. He has improved the technology with the support of Australian company, and soon after we had an operation producing 120 tones of barramundi, extended with the hydroponics filtration where grow different kinds of lettuce. Our first fish from new project was sold in 2009, till now. Selling this Australian prime fish grown in Poland and also expanding our operation to other species to be farmed in closed reticulated systems. Now is it building new facility with overall capacity of more than 1 200 tones of fresh fish per year.
